Conferences Guest Speakers

Colonel Emilio Sánchez de Rojas - UNSC

"Terrorism as an international threat to peace and security" (EN).

Mr. Sánchez de Rojas is a Colonel of Artillery DEM and expert in Intelligence, strategy and international relations. Needless to say, he has an extensive diplomatic and military experience abroad and a deep politico-military insight in the territory of Spain. He is a researcher at the Spanish Institute of Strategic Studies, professor and head of department at CESEDEN (Higher Center for Studies of National Defense), the main joint military training center of the Spanish Armed Forces. In addition, he is professor of several postgraduate programs related to intelligence, security and national and international defense.

Pilar Trinidad - UNHRC

"Child labor" (EN).

M. Trinidad is a Professor of Public International Law and International Relations at the Rey Juan Carlos University, Madrid, Spain. She holds a Doctorate in Law from the University of Extremadura (2001), when she was awarded the extraordinary doctorate prize for her Doctoral thesis on the status of children in International Law and International Human Rights. She has taught at different Universities of the Ibero-American Space as the University of Havana, University of Medellín in Colombia, Flacso in Ecuador or General San Martín University in Argentina.

Eduardo Barcesat - UNESCO***“Protección del patrimonio cultural en zonas de guerra” (SP).***

Mr. Barcesat is a professor on the Departments of Philosophy of Law, General Law Theory, Philosophy of Human Right and Constitutional Guarantees at the Law Faculty of the Universidad de Buenos Aires. It should be highlighted that Mr. Barcesat was a member of the Argentinian Constituent Convention in 1994, in which the Constitution of Argentina was reformed and modernized. Moreover, he is an ex Juridical External Consultant of the Procurement of the Argentinian National Treasury (2011/2015) and ex Juridical Advisor of the Presidency of the Deputies Chamber of Argentina (2011/2015). Currently, he is a renowned Human Rights Lawyer and leader of entities defending Human Rights since 1996.

Constanza Tamayo - UNEP***“Sustainable energies as a development factor” (SP).***

She studied Bacteriology at Institución Universitaria Colegio Mayor de Antioquia in Colombia and Biology at the University of Alcalá in Spain. Furthermore, she holds a PhD in Sciences and Microbiology from University of Alcalá, a MBA from the CEF, a Postgraduate Diploma in Organization Management and International Cooperation from the College of Political Scientists and Sociologists of Madrid and a Master's Degree in Marketing and Digital Communication from Camilo José Cela University. Her contribution in the international sphere in her area is vast. Not only she is part of the advisory body of the European Environment Agency (EEA) and the Innovative Financing Mechanism Program of the United Nations, but she is also part of the Economic and Social Development Programs in LATAM and Africa. She currently holds the position of Director General of Project Evaluation UE - LATAM.



Angelines Cano – UN WOMEN

“The promotion of gender equality in public institutions” (EN).

She works as a professor of International Public Law and International Relations at the Rey Juan Carlos University of Madrid. She holds an undergraduate Law degree from the Complutense University of Madrid and a PHD in Public International Law from the Rey Juan Carlos University of Madrid. She is currently Deputy Director of the Ibero-American Studies Center at U. Rey Juan Carlos and responsible for the Master's degree program in International Ibero-American Relations at U. Rey Juan Carlos as well. She has participated in numerous research projects and is a member of the Advisory or Editorial Board of several publications.

Clara Inés Guilló Girard - ACNUR

“Integration of refugees in target societies” (SP).

M. Guilló Girard works as an Associate Professor of the Department of Sociology at the Complutense University of Madrid and as a Professor of Postgraduate Studies at the Rey Juan Carlos University of Madrid. She holds a degree in Sociology from the Complutense University of Madrid and a Master's Degree in Migratory Studies from the University of Sussex, United Kingdom. Furthermore, she is a University Specialist in Equality and Gender Impact Assessment by the UNED and has a Diploma in Advanced Studies in Contemporary Dynamics of Social Transformations from the Complutense University of Madrid, where she is currently pursuing a Phd in Social Psychology. She is the coordinator of the Refugee Office and Shelter Plan of Universidad Complutense de Madrid and a permanent collaborator of the Chair of Gender of the URJC. In the past she has taught as well at UC3M and she has worked in the Office of Partnership for Development of the UAH.
